

IMPROVEMENTS Visitors & animals enjoy improved facilities



The Heritage Foundation is very proud to have funded two improvement projects at Bolado Park in 2012: upgrading the restrooms located near the arena and the livestock office, and installing cooling fans in the show rings.

Improvements to the restrooms included a new roof, sealed floors, paint and new fixtures. "Restroom facilities are very important to the families who visit the County Fair and we were glad to work with the 33rd Board to fund the request," said Bob Swanson, Heritage Foundation President.

The Foundation was happy to improve the experience for livestock participants and animals by installing cooling fans in the show

rings. The project was funded collaboratively by donations from Monsanto, 4-H, and FFA. The Foundation looks forward to working with community partners to continue to improve the fair experience.
